



"Enhancing energy connectivity and market integration in ASEAN to achieve energy security, accessibility, affordability and sustainability for all"

Phase II (2021-2025): Sub-theme

"Accelerating **Energy Transition** and Strengthening Energy Resilience through Greater Innovation and Cooperation"



ASEAN in Asia context

Roles of ACE:

- A platform to connect PV industry and the Governments
- Boosting PV deployment in the region
- Sharing the direction, needs and interests of the member states with APVIA





Why important to ASEAN

- Information sharing on the most advanced PV technologies
- Building network with PV industry, including the world largest manufacturers
- Support the growth of local manufacturers in regional market
- Accelerate the RE deployment in achieving ASEAN RE target of 23% of RE share in TPES by 2025 (5% to fill the gap from now)
- Accelerate ASEAN energy transition
- Keep governments informed with of the latest development of PV industry
- Governments set enablers to boost the PV deployment
- Nonetheless, ASEAN needs highly skilled human capital to improve their labour markets



RE Professional Certification with APVIA

- Objective:
 - 1. Improve regional competency of professionals in RE Project development
 - 2. Improve the deliverability of RE projects in ASEAN in accordance to achieve aspirational RE target of 23%
- **APAEC:** To support the effort to achieve the aspirational RE target of 23%
- Content:
 - 1. Training program on Solar PV projects in the first phase of implementation
 - Targeted expertise: Project Manager, Installer, System Designer, Safety Training
 - 3. Training program on other RE projects in the next phase of implementation such as Wind, Hydro, Geothermal
 - 4. Training and dissemination including promotional activities and development of pilot project.
